Biblical Leadership

• The biblical spiritual leader understands that his/her leadership is one of servanthood. The spiritual leader leads by example, as Jesus did, who said He came to serve others, not to be served by them (Matthew 20:25–28). The spiritual leader recognizes that he is first and foremost a servant. Jesus modeled the true servant style of leadership, when He, the Lord incarnate, bent down and washed the feet of His disciples, teaching them that the true measure of a leader is his willingness to first serve others (John 13:12–17).


Workplace Spirituality (NOT)

Workplace spirituality is not about organized practices. It is not about theology or about one's spiritual leader.

HOWEVER....

Workplace spirituality is about recognizing that it takes place in the context of an organizational community. Organizations that promote a spiritual culture recognize that employees have both a mind and a spirit, seek to find meaning and purpose in their work, and desire to connect with other employees and be part of a community. Spiritual Leadership in the Workplace Defined

• Spiritual leadership involves the application of spiritual values and principles to the workplace. The spiritual leader understands the importance of employees finding meaning in their work and demonstrates a genuine concern for the "whole person," not just the employee. How does spiritual leadership effect work?


- A leader's spirituality affects their vision and behavior and the subordinates' commitment is greatly influenced by the leader's vision and goals. The profitability, realization of values and vision and collective organizational responsibility to society and stakeholders accords a measure of a leaders' effectiveness. (NCBI)
- A spiritual leader directly effect cognitive-based trust and affect-based trust through the process of identifying vision and motivating faith/hope, which in turn increases followers' intrinsic motivation to implement creative ideas to pursue organizational vision. (Frontiers)



Ways to integrate spirituality into the workplace

- 1. Connect with your values- Many people search for a job that is high paying with great perks. Instead, find a place of employment focused on core values consistent with your own. Pay close attention to what companies stand for.
- 2. Be the example- What can you do to ease the burden for others? Begin by choosing your words and making them count. That means your words reflect your actions. Admit when you are wrong. Celebrate the accomplishments of others. Stay away from water cooler gossip.

Ways to integrate spirituality into the workplace (cont.)

3. Figure out what's important to your job- Take an active role by getting in tune with what's important to those around you. That could involve a workplace issue or something happening in their personal life. Keep the inspiration of others fueled and they will often return the favor.

4. Take a gifts inventory and take action- Part of spirituality is recognizing the gifts and goodness each one of us possesses. Once you have gone that extra mile, don't just discard the information. What you have learned, write it down and put this knowledge to work.

• 5. Create a work environment that fosters spirituality- There are two types of individuals. One divides people; the other bonds them. Aspire to be the latter. Shared purpose results in an enriched life experience. (International Institute For Spiritual Leaders)
